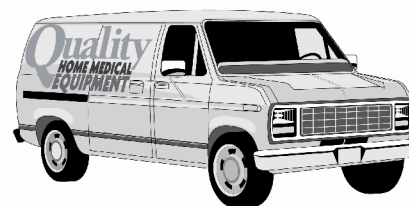

The Delivery Technician Certification™ Program (DTCP) is a national certification course for personnel responsible for medical equipment delivery, set up, and patient education. The course also tests the delivery technicians understanding and comprehension of the federal rules and regulations governing the delivery of medical equipment and potentially hazardous materials such as oxygen and nitrous oxide gases.

The DTCP addresses the Department of Transportation (DOT) rules and regulations regarding commercial motor vehicles, HAZMAT training, and drug and alcohol testing. It also covers OSHA universal precaution training as well as HIPAA privacy requirements and the federal security regulations.



Upon completion of the DTCP and receiving a passing grade on the certification test a delivery technician is now a certified delivery technician. This certification is good for three years and recertification can be obtained via attending another DTCP or taking an on-line recertification test.

The DTCP examines the delivery technician's working knowledge of the following areas:

- DOT HAZMAT regulations
- Best Delivery Practices
- OSHA Universal Precautions training
- Drug & Alcohol Testing regulations
- HIPAA Privacy Rule requirements
- Industry Standards applications

In addition, with certified delivery technicians, the HME/home healthcare business can limit its liabilities in such areas as:

- Vehicle care and maintenance
- Vehicle and driver compliance with DOT regulations
- Infection control
- Accidents with vehicles
- Hazardous Materials incidents
- Equipment setup and education errors
- Home safety assessments
- Proper documentation retention

Who should attend the DTCP:

- Store Owners
- Managers
- Dispatchers
- Drivers
- Technicians
- Respiratory Therapists.

Accrediting organizations and CMS Quality Standards dictate that all personnel involved with the delivery of equipment and supplies, as well as patient education and care, understand the federal regulations governing the delivery of home healthcare. In addition, accrediting organizations also require all personnel involved with patient care have a working knowledge of industry accepted standards and practices. All of these areas are addressed in the DTCP!

With fee schedule and industry standards changes coming soon, successful HME/home healthcare businesses cannot afford to have anything but trained and certified delivery technicians on their staff. Enroll your key staff in this program to protect your patients and your business!
